DUE TO THE ATTRACTIVE DESIGN OF THE ZAXXON JOYSTICK HANDLE, WE HAVE RECEIVED SEVERAL REPORTS OF THEM BEING REMOVED. AS A PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE, WE SUGGEST YOU TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS IMMEDIATELY:

- 1. REMOVE THE THREE ALLEN SCREWS FROM THE JOYSTICK AND CLEAN THE THREADED AREAS WITH LOCQUIC PRIMER "T" OR EQUIVALENT. A SUGGESTED METHOD IS TO SATURATE A Q-TIP WITH THE PRIMER "T" AND SWAB BOTH THREADED AREAS COMPLETELY. BLOW OFF THE EXCESS AND ALLOW TO DRY 3 TO 5 MINUTES.
- 2. COAT THE ENTIRE THREAD WITH LOCTITE 721 ADHESIVE/SEALANT OR EQUIVALENT.
 REINSTALL BACK IN THE HANDLE AND TORQUE TO A VALUE OF 50 INCH POUNDS.
- 3. APPLY SOME TYPE OF BLACK SEALING COMPOUND. WE SUGGEST DURO MUFFLER TAILPIPE SEALER. THIS WILL HIDE THE ALLEN SCREWS FROM VIEW BUT IS EASILY REMOVED WITH AN APPROPRIATE TOOL FOR SERVICING.

THESE MATERIALS ARE AVAILABLE AT A NOMINAL COST AT MOST HARDWARE OR AUTO PARTS

THIS IS AN INTERIM FIX. WE WILL BE PROVIDING TAMPER-PROOF SCREWS ON THIS JOYSTICK ON FUTURE SHIPMENTS.

In the advent that you may wish to remove the Component Shelf Assembly (P/N 800-3243) entirely, the following procedure is recommended:

- 1. Refer to your Owner's Manual (P/N 420-0724), pages 35 and 89. The only tools you will need are; an 11/32" nutdriver, a 7/16" nutdriver, and a pair of dikes (wirecutters).
- 2. Begin by fitting the 11/32" nutdriver, and with the game electronics compartment door open, remove the nut securing the multiple ground strap connection on the back end of the junction box (mounted on the left-hand side of the cabinet interior).
- 3. The top "eye-crimp" should be the ground strap from the Component Shelf Assy. From the shelf end, follow the strap from the shelf to the junction box, cutting the tie wraps as needed to free this particular ground strap from the rest of the harnessing.
- 4. Disconnect and mark for later identification the following connectors: P4 and P31 to the monitor (access may be easier from the back door); P5, P30, and in order from back to front (refer to pg. 89), connectors C, B, A, H, F, G, and E.
- 5. With the 7/16" nutdriver, remove the four bolts securing the Component Shelf Assy. to the cabinet (two located on the upper corners of the back vertical panel, and the remaining two located at the front of the shelf, lying horizontally).
- 6. The Component Shelf Assy. should now be free to slide, <u>SLOWLY</u> forward to a point 2-3" short of the 1 X 4 cross-brace in the upper-front of the compartment. Grasp the shelf with both hands on the vertical panel, supporting the horizontal panel with your forearms. Expect the majority of the weight on your left. Now, <u>CAREFULLY</u> tilt the bottom up slightly, pivoting the Assy. back, and forward. Take care to allow ample clearance of the upper cross-brace.
- 7. Installation is a simple reversal of the removal procedure.

On page 31, Item No. 72, delete the "2" following "Component Shelf Assy". On page 32, 'cut and paste' or add by hand the following addendum;

Top Assembly Numbers 700-0087 -05 through -12 are identical to -00 through -04, EXCEPT FOR Monitor and Component Shelf Assy type, as shown here:


In the event that your ZAXXON Joystick Assembly (P/N 800-3272) is tending to bind or seize up, the simple procedure outlined in the following pages provides a solution; (installation of a flat washer under the Shaft Ring):

ZAXXONTM Joystick Anti-Galling Modification Instructions

- 1. Turn on the game to be retro-fitted, manipulate the joystick handle (ITEM NO. 14) to verify proper operation of the 8-way player input assembly (P/N 834-0236), or if the joystick assembly is seized completely, actuate the four micro-switches from underneath the control panel.
- 2. Turn the game off and proceed. The only part required is a 7/16" I.D. steel USS flat washer. The tools you will need are: a small phillips screwdriver, a small flat-head screwdriver, a pair of dikes (wire-cutters), and a pair of crimp pliers if you intend to use blind crimps in Step 8.
- 3. With the door to the game electronics compartment open, reach under the control panel and flip the latches on both sides. The panel will now swing out towards you. Disconnect the control panel harness connector on the right-side, slide the spring-loaded pins on both sides, remove the control panel and set on a good working surface (placed upside down on a padded armchair is ideal, allowing you to approach the underside of the panel with ample joystick clearance beneath).
- 4. Notice at the end of the joystick assembly the three wires exiting the shaft (ITEM NO. 4). Tag each wire TWICE (one wire with two A's or 1's, another wire with two B's or 2's, etc.) to ease later identification for re-wiring, and cut each wire BETWEEN the two tags.
- 5. Next, remove the four phillips screws (ITEM NO. 16) securing the microswitch bracket (bracket B, ITEM NO. 3) and set aside for re-use. Lift the bracket (ITEM NO. 3) up off of the shaft, and carefully set it back out of the way.
- 6. At this point, applying pressure on the spring holder (ITEM NO. 7) with one hand, use the flat-head screwdriver with your other hand to pry (in a twisting motion) the 9mm E-washer (ITEM NO. 25) off of the main shaft (ITEM NO. 4). The Compression Spring (ITEM NO. 12) together with the Spring Holder and Shaft Ring (ITEM NO. 6) are now free to lift off of the Main Shaft. Install the 7/16" flat washer now, over the shaft, resting on the Joystick Bracket (ITEM NO. 2). Re-install the Shaft Ring, Compression Spring, Spring Holder and E-washer in the reverse order of their removal. ITEM NO. 27 is the flat-washer.
- 7. Re-position the micro-switch bracket B (ITEM NO. 3) over the shaft

- (ITEM NO. 4) and re-secure the four phillips screws (ITEM NO. 16) removed in Step 5. NOTE: These are metric screws, and if one is lost or damaged, it may be replaced with a 6-32 thread forming screw.
- 8. Next, strip approximately 3/8" of insulation from the ends of all six wires (three wires from the shaft, and three from the control panel). Secure all three connections with blind crimps or wire nuts, according to the tags affixed in Step 4.
- 9. Re-position the now complete control panel assembly to the front of the game and slide the spring-loaded pins back into place. Replace the control panel harness connector, rotate the panel into its operating position and secure the side latches.
- 10. Close the game electronics compartment door, turn the game on and verify proper operation of your joystick assembly.

We have shipped two versions of ZAXXON as it relates to the Joystick/ Flying Ship interface.

In our opinion, the typical table game player would prefer to have the ship ascend by pushing the joystick forward and descend by pulling the joystick back.

The player that has played the upright version and now plays the table version, would want the ship to ascend by pulling the joystick back, and descend by pushing the joystick forward.

Both versions have been shipped to our distributors. To modify this facet of the game is quite simple and can be accomplished by following these instructions:

- Facing the open table from the Player One position, locate the harness connector for the Player One control panel located at the left corner of the monitor, nearest you.
- 2. Seperate the two halves of the connector.
- On the female half of this connector, locate pin numbers 3 and 4. Numbers are stamped on the back side.
- 4. Reverse the wire positions of pins 3 and 4, and re-make the connector halves.
- Locate the Player Two control panel harness connector at the far left-side of the monitor.
- Repeat Steps 2, 3, and 4.
 This completes the modification.

NOTE: Removal of connector pins may require the use of a pin extractor. This extractor is available from AMP Inc., part no. 458994-1-0.
