Symptom: Intermittently the displays will say "Memory

Error Open Door" when the game is turned on. The only way to get the game to power up is to open and close the front door. This is the same

symptom that a loose or missing battery will

exhibit.

Problem: Very obscure program error.

Solution: Accompanying this bulletin are two EPROMS

labeled B5 and C5. They are your master EPROMS and do not need to be returned to us. They are version $\lambda 02-7$. This new program version will

correct this problem.

Note: This is a back ground systems error and is very

intermittent. You may never hear of it. We

recommend you do two things:

You only send this program to those customers of Yours

that complain specifically of this problem.

2) Install wersion A02-7 EPROMS into any Back to the Future game you get coming through your shop.
