RE:

Last Action Hero/Jurassic Park - Flipper Return Springs

Symptom:

When flipper is energized it does not return to it's rest position after releasing

the flipper button.

Problem:

Flipper return spring has broken off the spring bracket (FIG. 1). We have found a number of these machines which have had the end of the spring crimped to the spring bracket to secure it from popping off. This is not nec-

essary and will cause premature spring failure.

Solution:

Replace spring (Part No.: 265-5029-02). This is not a modified spring, it is an

exact replacement part without the crimp.

Note:

I am sending you along with this Service Bulletin, a package of one hundred (100) flipper return springs (PN: 265-5029-02). This should cover your stock

if you or your customers should have a problem.
